## Advanced course on Biomechanics of the Trees Pistoia (Italy) 5-9 June 2017

The course will be held in Pistoia hosted by the Uniser Consortium (Via Pertini, 358) at walking distance from Pistoia railway station.



# How to arrive in Pistoia

### Airports

- Florence (FLR), 1 hour: outside the arrival area, turn right and walk for 100 m to the taxis and/or shuttle bus "<u>VolainBus</u>", destination railway station named "Santa Maria Novella", then take a train to Pistoia (see above).
- Pisa (PSA), 1.30 hour: outside the arrival area turn left and take the <u>People Mover</u> to the railway station "Pisa Centrale" (second stop), then take a train to Florence then to Pistoia (see above)
- Pisa (PSA), 1.30 hour: outside the arrival area you will find 2-3 bus companies that serve the Route Pisa Airport-Florence Station then take a train to Pistoia (see above)
- Bologna (BLQ), 1.30 hours: outside the arrival area you will find 1-2 bus companies that serve the Route Bologna Airport-Florence Station then take a train to Pistoia (see above). You can also take the shuttle bus to the Railway Station in Bologna and then take the high-speed train to Florence



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### Trains

Tickets can be purchased in advance via <u>Trenitalia website</u>; you don't need to print the ticket, but you have to show the pdf you will receive via e-mail.

- Florence Santa Maria Novella: quick train to Pistoia (33-37 min) every half an hour at 15 and 43 minutes (8.15; 8.43; 9.15; 9.43...) from 5am to 10pm.
- Pisa Centrale: no direct connection, you have to change in Lucca or Florence.

# Accommodation

We can suggest to check local website to select your favorite accommodation
